

Pet Emergency Preparedness Checklist

Emergency Contact Information

- Veterinarian's name and phone number
- Local emergency veterinary clinic name, address, and phone number
- Poison control number (ASPCA Animal Poison Control: 888-426-4435)

Pet Identification

- Recent photo of your pet
- Microchip number and registration
- Pet ID tags with up-to-date contact information

Medical Information

- List of medical conditions
- Current medications and dosages
- Known allergies
- Vaccination records

Supplies and Essentials

- Leash and collar/harness
- Carrier or crate
- Food and water (3-day supply minimum)
- Bowls for food and water
- Poop bags or litter box with litter
- Toys and blanket

First Aid Kit (Pet Specific)

- Gauze, bandages, tape
- Antiseptic wipes and antibiotic ointment
- Digital thermometer

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- Hydrogen peroxide (to induce vomiting if directed by vet)
- Tweezers and blunt-tip scissors
- Pet-safe pain reliever (as advised by your vet)

Evacuation Preparedness

- List of pet-friendly hotels or boarding facilities
- Copy of this checklist in evacuation bag
- Practice evacuation with your pet
